

The Pre-harvest advance application has two parts.

## When to complete Part 1

- The applicant's land has not yet been seeded.

## When to complete Part 2

- No application was made under Part 1 and the applicant's land has been seeded.
- An application was made under Part 1 but the actual seeded acres are different than the anticipated seeded acres.
- An application was made under Part 1 but after seeding, the applicant is applying for a larger advance than the original amount.
- An application was made under Part 1 but the applicant or a related producer applied for more money after the first payment was issued.

### Using crop insurance coverage, you require

- CWB 10-digit producer ID number. If the applicant does not have a CWB 10-digit producer ID number, they must apply for a CWB delivery permit. Call us or go to our Web site to get an application.
- Crop insurance contract number.
- Crop insurance coverage in tonnes per acre for wheat (by class), durum and barley. (See Applicant's eligibility information sheet.)
- Anticipated seeded acres or actual seeded acres (based on the applicant's Seeded Acreage Report) of wheat, durum and barley.
- Applicant's total previous 2011-12 (include winter wheat advances) wheat, durum and barley Pre-harvest advances received (including those of any related producers).
- Applicant's total previous 2011-12 Pre-harvest advances received from all other organizations on all other agricultural products (crops and livestock), including those of any related producers.
- Outstanding principal balance of applicant's 2010-11 cash advance(s), including those of any related producers (include 2009-10 and 2008-09 advances where default has been stayed) received from the CWB and all other organizations on all agricultural products (crops and livestock).

### Using AgriStability coverage, you require

- CWB 10-digit producer ID number. If the applicant does not have a CWB 10-digit producer ID number, they must apply for a CWB delivery permit. Call us or go to our Web site to get an application.
- AgriStability personal identification number (PIN).
- Anticipated seeded acres or actual seeded acres of wheat, durum and barley and estimated yield.
- AgriStability reference margin and any interim payments received.
- AgriStability security used for previous wheat, durum and barley advances and for all other agricultural products.
- Applicant's total previous 2011-12 (include winter wheat advances) wheat and barley Pre-harvest advances received (including those of any related producers).
- Applicant's total previous 2011-12 Pre-harvest advances received from all other organizations on all other agricultural products (crops and livestock), including those of any related producers.
- Outstanding principal balance of applicant's 2010-11 cash advance(s), including those of any related producers (include 2009-10 advances where default has been stayed), received from the CWB and all other organizations on all agricultural products (crops and livestock).
