

The CWB has a delivery provision to help producers offset the cost of purchasing pedigreed wheat, durum or barley seed. This provision only applies to the purchase of pedigreed seed for CWB marketed grains.

- Deliveries of wheat or durum can be used to purchase wheat, durum or selected barley pedigreed seed. (e.g., producers can deliver durum to purchase pedigreed wheat seed).
- The grain must be delivered and settled in the same crop year the seed was purchased.
- Sign-up deadline for the 2011-12 crop year is June 29, 2012 with cash tickets settled by July 31.

## Calculating how much can be delivered

**Cost of seed ÷ Net initial price\* = Maximum tonnes eligible for delivery**

\*Net initial price is the gross initial price minus deductions like freight, dockage, handling and elevation.

### Producers

- A CWB delivery contract is required to deliver wheat or durum to offset the cost of pedigreed wheat, durum or barley seed.
- Sign the completed 2011-12 Deliveries to purchase pedigreed seed (DPPS) delivery contract form. Once completed, the elevator will fax the contract form to the CWB at 1-204-983-8031.
- Immediate delivery once delivery contract is active
- Contract is 100-per-cent accepted and there are no delivery calls
- Grain must be delivered and settled in the same crop year the seed was purchased.
- Supply a copy of the sales invoice at the request of the CWB (on request).

### Elevator representative

- A CWB delivery contract is required to deliver wheat or durum to offset the cost of pedigreed wheat, durum or barley seed.
- Complete a 2011-12 Deliveries to purchase pedigreed seed (DPPS) delivery contract form.
- Ensure all signatures are on the DPPS contract form before faxing the form to the CWB.
- Record the contract number and tonnes in the producer's delivery permit book.
- Report the delivery contract number on the cash ticket.

Grain deliveries made under this authorization are not subject to any deductions under the *Prairie Grain Advance Payments Act*, the *Agricultural Marketing Programs Act*, the *Spring Credit Advance Program* or the *Enhanced Spring Credit Advance Program* unless an advance was issued on the tonnes being delivered.
