

Value-added Incentive Program

The CWB offers a value-added direct delivery incentive program (VIP) that will put more money into your pocket.

Producers who deliver their wheat and barley directly to eligible mills and malting plants in Western Canada will receive a premium of \$3 per tonne.

The VIP is part of the CWB's on-going commitment to value-added processing on the Prairies. The program provides earlier delivery opportunities, reduces storage and carrying costs for the CWB, and has the potential to lower your handling costs.

Current CWB carrying costs range between \$3 and \$4 dollars per tonne when grain sits in the elevator - this is the amount paid to the handling company. Through the VIP, money that would have been paid to a grain company is instead paid to you. Millers and maltsters will also benefit from more timely access to the grade and quantity of wheat, durum and malting barley required.

Getting the VIP-premium is easy. The CWB will automatically issue cheques for direct delivery premiums based on cash tickets submitted by mills and malting plants. The CWB pays you monthly for direct-delivery.
